DUTIES

spend a minimum of one, 3-4-hour shift per week on the trail through the busy summer and fall season talking to park visitors, answering questions and serving as an important on-site presence



SKILLS

enjoys working with people, has a basic knowledge of local plants, animals, and the park itself and feels comfortable working independently on-trail, away from their vehicle for several hours at a time
